We resumed regular classes at Women's Team centre in accordance with COVID guidelines.

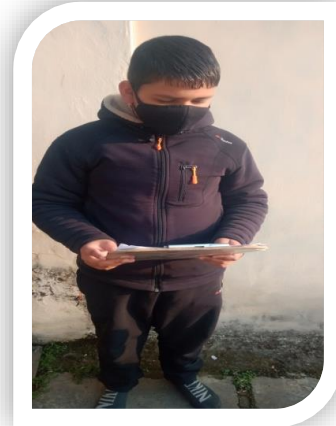
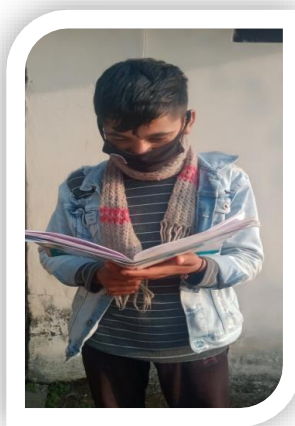
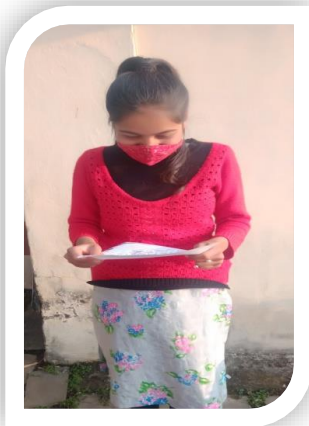
Celebration of Lohri:
